Before Buying a Machine, consider the following:

- How will you transport the machine? (pickup truck, trailer, box truck...) The basic issue is how portable the machine needs to be. Some machines have wheels, some are lighter than others, and others are best mounted in a truck and not moved.
- What power requirements does it have? Consider how you will plug in the machine. Will you use power off the house or use a generator (10KW or larger)?
- How often will the machine be used? Is this a small part of the business (use the machine 1-2 times per month) or is it a focus for your business (used 3-5 times a week)?
- What type of jobs are you focused on? Larger commercial, residential retrofits, attics only...
